Any additional information. Eg length of build/cost of build/reason for build	IT TOOK 7 YEARS TO BUILD (1988-1995). THE 1913 BUILDING COULD HOUSE UP TO 500,000 ITEMS. THE COLLECTION GREW OVER THE YEARS AND BEFORE 1995 USED TO ON SEVERAL LOCATIONS IN ZAGREB AND ITS SURROUNDINGS.
