

OUR MISSION

The National Library is a centre that holds the National Bibliographic Heritage of Spain and it aims to:

- Preserve, manage and disseminate the Spanish Bibliographic Heritage in any format
- Collect, catalogue and preserve the publications in any area
- Promote research, especially in the area of Humanities, by means of requests, study, book loan, etc.
- Elaborate and disseminate the information about the Spanish publications
- Carry out any library work, preservation, growth and dissemination of the National Bibliographic Heritage
- Develop research programs and cooperate with other libraries and other cultural and scientific institutions that can contribute to the best development of the aims of the National Library
- Create, coordinate and encourage research and development programs in the areas of its competency to satisfy the needs of the research community
- Contribute to the transformation of information into knowledge

SUMMARY OF THE YEAR

The Ministry of Culture appointed Milagros Del Corral Beltrán as the new General Director of the National Library last September 2007. She has brought a new way of managing daily library works and library cooperation with other cultural institutions both inside and outside Spain. It is especially remarkable her commitment with the European projects under the eContentplus programme and the works to finally present the Biblioteca Digital Hispánica last October 2007.

The [Biblioteca Digital Hispánica](#) gives access to the most outstanding works of the National Library of Spain and allows the largest documentary collection in the country to be offered to the public; a service that will allow researching, consulting and analysing the fundamental texts of the Hispanic culture (from a collection of 10.000 works: manuscripts, drawings, printed books from 15-19th century, photographs and maps). In January 2008 the Library signed an Agreement with the Ministry of Culture and the company Telefónica to develop the Hispanic Digital Library project; the Library has started a mass digitisation program to accomplish the goal proposed to the European Commission to digitise 200.000 works in five years.

This process of giving online free access to the Spanish Bibliographic Heritage preserved at the National Library had a first stage giving public access to the [Hemeroteca Digital](#), a digital library of Spanish old newspapers and magazines with 143 titles, edited between 1772 and 1933. That means free access to 500.000 digitised pages. The Library also presented the [Bibliografía Española en Línea](#) (Online Spanish Bibliography), an online free service that provides immediate access to the bibliographic records that are part of the Spanish publishing output, incorporated into the National Library by means of Legal Deposit.

The Library has initiated the process of implementing a new Integrated Library Management System to replace the Ariadna system. The Sirsi-Dynis is the company that will develop this library automation. This new system will allow the automation of all library tasks and will provide more and better services for its users. This project will be developed in two years starting in 2007, with an initial phase, already operational, devoted to the migration of over 3,000,000 bibliographic references that are currently available and to the implementation of the cataloguing and authority control module and the Internet user consultation module (OPAC), as well as the users' module. The second phase will include the implementation of purchase, traffic and serial publications management modules.

LEGAL DEPOSIT

The National Library of Spain is the main information and document centre regarding Spanish and Latin American culture in written form, due to the status it has enjoyed as the depository body for published material in Spain since the beginning of 18th century, received by means of Legal Deposit. The bibliographic collection is also built up by remaining procedures like purchases, auctions, exchange and donations.

The Legal Deposit is currently governed at a State level by means of the Orders of the Ministry of Education and Culture of 30th October 1971 and 20th February 1973, but the National Library together with the Library Cooperation Forum of the Ministry of Culture and the Autonomous Regions, have been trying for years to instigate a new law on Legal Deposit to guarantee the preservation of Spanish digital contents, given that the current legislation does not envisage this essential task. A draft new bill, under preparation, is expected to be discussed in Parliament early 2009.

The map of Juan de la Cruz is one of the most outstanding maps in South America printed in Europe at the 18th century.

CATALOGUING

The Bibliographic Control Department develops the database that includes the cataloguing of all that it is published every year in Spain. Over the year 2007, 219.338 bibliographic records and 965.380 holdings have been entered into the database. It has also been entered 325 titles and 964 collections in the Union Catalogue of Serial Publications. [See Figure 1]

Last year a new Integrated Library System was implemented to replace Ariadna and over 3,000,000 bibliographic references had to be migrated. All this information is currently available and the implementation of the cataloguing and authority control module and the internet user consultation module (OPAC).

In the near future it will be included the implementation of purchase, traffic and serial publications management modules.

The Library is also making a special effort in terms of normalisation of cataloguing; actually, the Library works in those issues both at national and international working groups contributing with its local experience.

- *España en el Mediterráneo: la construcción del espacio*, from 14th December 2006 until 11th March 2007. It showed the Spanish presence at the Mediterranean through Technology, Engineering and Town Planning from the 15th century to the beginning of 18th century
