




Who's involved

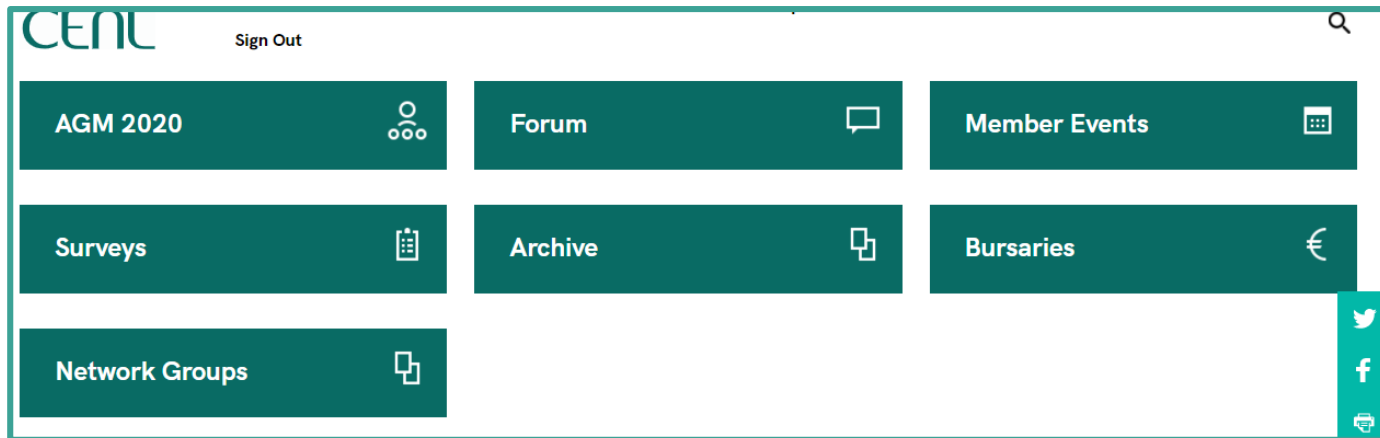

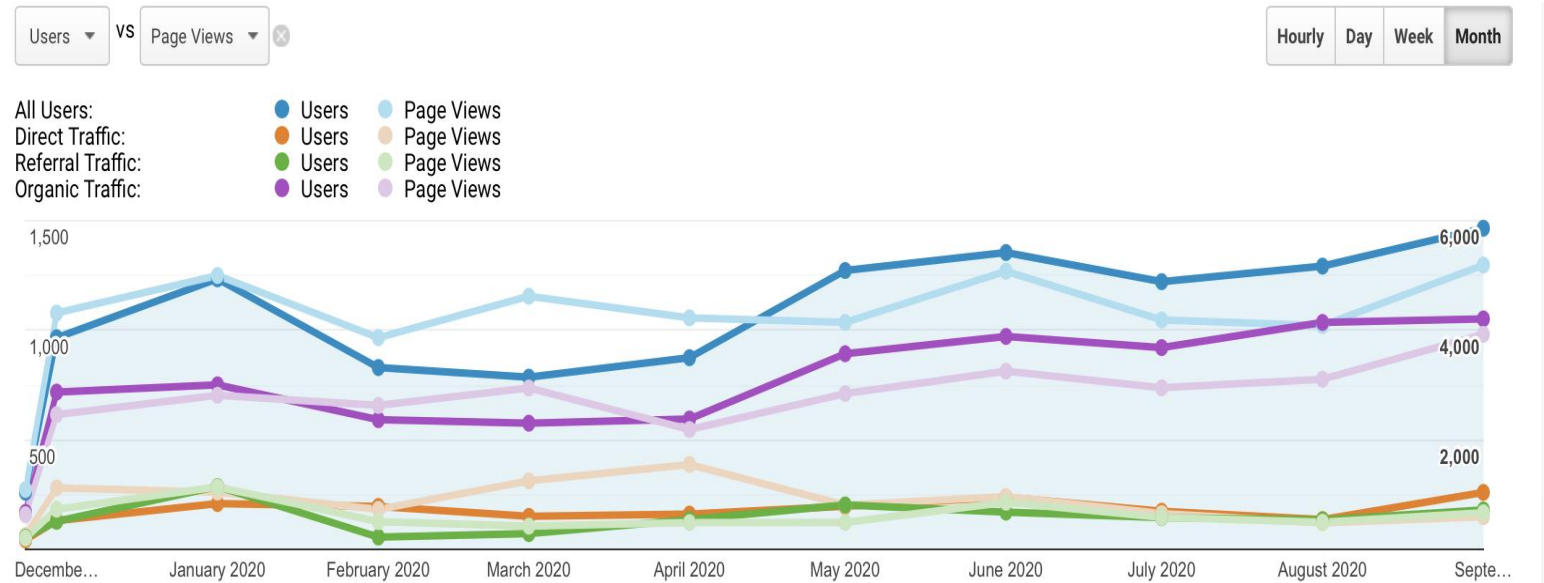

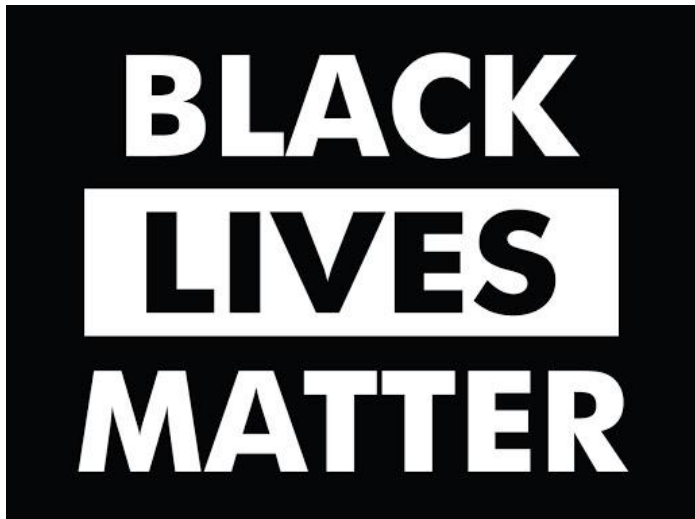
