LAURENCE ENGEL

President of BnF

Laurence Engel has been nominated to be President of the BnF in April 2016, and saw her position renewed in 2021 for a second mandate.

She devoted her professional career to cultural public policies, in particular for the French-German television channel Arte, for the Ministry of Culture, where she worked as a permanent Secretary for French Minister of Culture Aurélie Filippetti (2021-2014), and for the City of Paris, as Director of Cultural Affairs. She is also the President of Réseau Francophone Numérique, an international non-profit association, which currently comprises 30 members (national libraries, national archives, university libraries, institutes) in 20 countries.

FRANK SCHOLZE

Director General National Library of Germany

Frank Scholze succeeded to the post of Director General of the German National Library in January 2020. After completing his studies in library science, art history and English, he took part in various digital library projects and was in charge of the user services department at Stuttgart University Library. In 2010, following two years at the Ministry of Science, Research and the Arts in Baden-Württemberg, he was appointed director of the library of the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT).

From 2016 to 2022, he was a member of the federal executive committee of the German Library Association (dbv). He is am member of numerous other scientific committees and councils, including the academic council of German National Library of Science and Technology Hannover (TIB) and the ETH Library Lab. Since December 2021, he has been chairman of CENL.



GUILLAUME LAFORTUNE

Vice President and Director of the Paris office of the Sustainable Development Solutions Network

Guillaume Lafortune is Vice President and Head of the Paris Office at the UN Sustainable Development Solutions Network (SDSN) - the largest network of experts and practitioners mobilized for the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

He joined SDSN in 2017 to lead work on SDG data, policies, and financing including the preparation of the annual Sustainable Development Report. Previously, he served as an economist at the OECD in Paris and at the Ministry of Economic Development in the Government of Quebec (Canada).

Guillaume was honoured to receive the Gold Medal at the IPAC/CAPPA National Student and Thought Leadership Award in Canada in 2013. He is the author of 40+ scientific publications, book chapters, policy briefs and international reports on sustainable development, economic policy and good governance



HARRI SAHAVIRTA

Chair of IFLA ENSULIB

Harri Sahavirta holds a Ph.D. in philosophy. He works as a chief librarian at Helsinki City Library, Finland. In addition, he is the chair of ENSULIB in IFLA (2021-2023). He has studied philosophy in University of Helsinki and his other areas of LIS expertise are sustainability and libraries, promotion of adults literacy and reading as well as library soundscapes.



FROM CHARLES DE GAULLE (CDG) AIRPORT TO THE HOTEL

Once you have arrived at the airport Charles de Gaulle (CDG), you have three options to get to your hotel in Bercy. These include taxi, train and bus.



Transfer from CDG to Bercy by Taxi:

Duration: approx. 30 minutes

Costs: approx. 75 Euro



Transfer from CDG to Bercy by Train RER B and Métro 6:

Duration: approx. 1 hour.

Costs: appr. 12 Eur

The station at CDG Airport is located at Terminal 2. Tickets can be prepurchased or bought on the place at the ticket counter.

Take a RER B train to "Denfert-Rocherau" and then change to a Metro train number 6 direction "Nations" to "Bercy".



FROM ORLY AIRPORT TO IBIS BERCY VILLAGE HOTEL

Once you have arrived at the airport Paris-Orly (ORY), you have two options to get to your hotel in Bercy.



Transfer from ORY to Bercy by Taxi:

Duration: approx. 15 minutes

Costs: approx. 35 Euro

Taxis are waiting at the Terminal 1-2 (door 14a), Terminal 3 (door 32a),

Terminal 4 (door 48a).



Transfer from ORY to Bercy by Orlybus and Metro 6:

Duration: approx. 50 min.

Costs: appr. 15 Eur

There are Orlybus stations at the Terminal 4 and at the Terminal 1-2-3. Tickets can be pre-purchased or bought at the ticket machine.

Take the Orlybus to "Denfert-Rochereau" and then change to a Metro train number 6 direction "Nations" to "Bercy".



RECOMMENDATION

We recommend to buy Metro tickets in advance (on the train) to avoid longer waiting times.
